Once a month, the leadership team will be available for what we call an Open Forum. The Open Forum is where you can raise concerns, ask questions, give advice or share a compliment regarding any aspect of the school. This meeting is located in our conference room; further details will be sent home to you regarding the first meeting.

If at any time you have a question, have heard a rumor or want clarification on an issue please do not hesitate to contact me, one of my fellow leadership team members or if it pertains to your child your child's teacher. Often misconceptions occur when the right person is not asked the question or the question is not asked in the first place. Often questions/comments regarding the school on Facebook and other social media can cause concern. As a school we believe in open communication – I cannot promise you will always like the answer but I will definitely respond to you. We want our school to provide an excellent education for your child, we need all our parents to work with us to enable us to achieve this vision.

I am very excited about the upcoming academic year and I look forward to working with you, the Primary PYP staff, your child and other students to make the Primary PYP section of RAKA a strong and successful community of learners.
